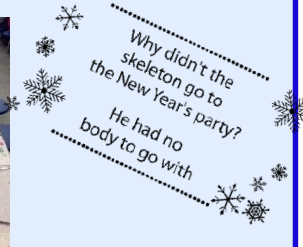


Almost there!

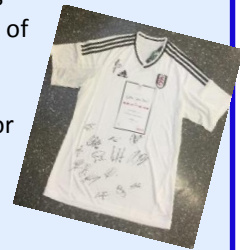
Drama & Singing Lessons of Distinction

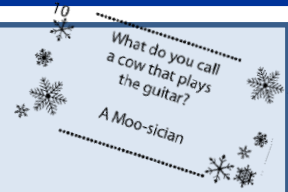

Booking Troubleshooting Tips

- Find the correct day of the club you wish to reserve a place for your child
- Use the 'Change Child' button on the blue bar to move between children.
- Only clubs which your child is able to take part in (age/year group related) will be available for you to view
- The child's date of birth has to be entered in exactly the right format e.g using four digits for the year of birth - 12/09/2009
- If you do not have access to a computer and are therefore unable to book an appointment online then please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
- The system will limit each child to 2 clubs each.
