Another week has flown by in the blink of an eye! This week in Reception we began to explore measure in maths. Our maths scheme, *Maths Mastery*, has a heavy focus on vocabulary, so while the concepts of size and length were a breeze, we found structuring comparative sentences a lot trickier! In literacy we enjoyed some drama as we assumed the characters of the old woman and the granddaughter from our story, *The Old Woman and the Pumpkin*. We explored points of view and expressing our opinions.

In Nursery, the children immersed themselves in the story of The Gingerbread Man. The children made predictions and speculated about what characters the gingerbread man might meet on his journey, and did some problem-solving to design and build bridges to get the gingerbread man safely across the river. The children observed lots of cause and effect and trial and error to build there functioning bridges!
