Runny nose season is here and boxes of tissues are in need. If you are able to donate any, please hand these to your class teacher.

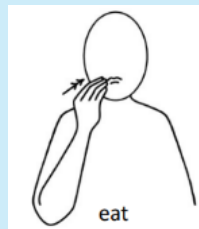
Food in the Morning

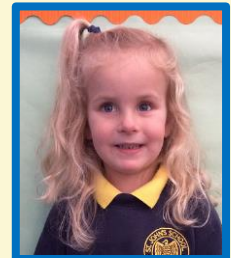

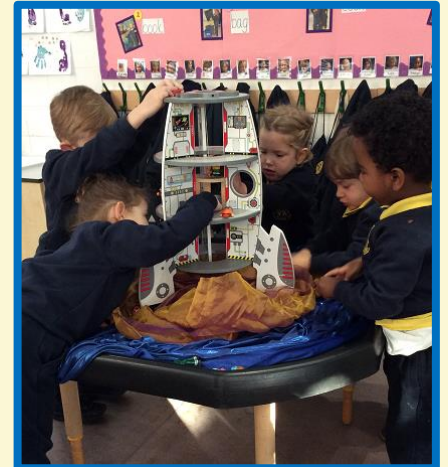
Next Week
