This week we celebrated *National Story Telling Week* and as a school we focused on oral story telling, looking at the traditional tale of Little Red Riding Hood.

In Early Years, we explored different ways we could orally retell the story; using costume, puppets and props. We sequenced the story, recognised the different emotions of characters and their role within the story. We enjoyed getting into character, using repeated refrains and new vocabulary within our play.



We developed our story telling skills by learning the value of adding expression at specific points, pausing before a key part and incorporating actions alongside. We loved sharing our videos of us retelling the story with our friends and felt very proud to showcase our oral story telling abilities and new found confidence!

Physical Development

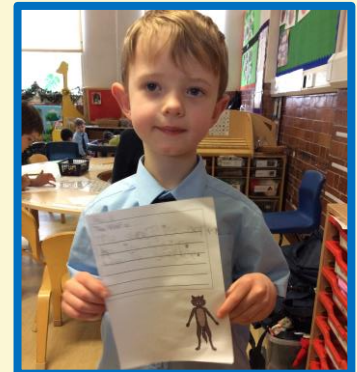
In class, we will be discussing the importance of exercise and meaningful movement to support our mental and physical wellbeing.
