Reception

Our learning this week

This week we have started our tooth brushing sessions in class. We have had some very helpful 'Teeth Brushing Experts' come down from Year 6 to support us. A huge thank you to them and well done to Reception for being so sensible with new routines and challenges!



Next Week

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be talking about what we are good at and recognising what others are good at.

Communication, Language and English

We will be exploring the Traditional Tale 'Three Billy Goats Gruff'. We will be using our phonics to write descriptive words and practise our ability to map a story. In Phonics we will be learning the graphemes 'y', 'z', 'zz', 'qu' and 'ch'. We will learn the HRSW words 'we', 'me' and 'be'.

Religious Education

We will be introducing the children to the Nativity story, discussing what this means to Christians.

Physical Development

In our PE lesson, we will be developing our ability to use large muscle movements.

Mathematics

We will continue to explore addition and subtraction, using a part whole model and bead strings.

Understanding the World

We will be discussing the importance of Remembrance Day and recognising the importance of a minute silence.

Nursery

Our learning this week

In Nursery, we have been practising our name writing using our name writing cards. We have been learning to hold our pen with a tri pod grip and follow the lines to create the letters of our name.



Next Week

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Whilst looking at the text 'Bedtime for Monsters'. We will talk about how to be brave and to give advice to a friend. Later in the week, we will focus on reflecting on other's accomplishments as we talk about Remembrance Day.

Communication, Language and English

We will be developing an enjoyment for listening to longer books. We will also build our ability to describe events through re-enactment; focusing on using prepositions.

Physical Development

We will be using large and small equipment to explore journeys and travelling.

Mathematics

We will be exploring height; comparing our own height to the things around us, making sense of ourselves in the space around us.

Understanding the World

We will be thinking about transportation and different ways people travel. We will look at different homes and habitats, creating a cave like the one in our text. Later in the week, we will look at the importance of Remembrance Day.

Expressive art and design

We will be creating our own monsters through paint, folded paper and egg cartons.
