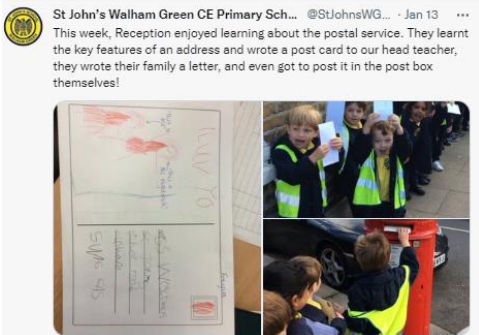

This week

Reception have enjoyed learning about people who help us this week; developing our learning through role play!



Next Week

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be discussing the importance of overcoming obstacles and playing to our strengths, as a learner and individual.

Communication, Language and English

We will be exploring the text 'Here We Are'; looking at adjectives to compare locations and developing our sentence writing skills. In Phonics, we will be learning the graphemes 'ure', 'er' and 'ow'. We will be learning the HRSW 'ball' and 'tall'.

Physical Development

In our PE lesson, we will develop our ball skills through the skill of rolling.

Mathematics

We will be developing our understanding of calendar and time; looking at days of the week, seasons, sequencing daily events and measuring short periods of time with accuracy.

Understanding the World
