It has been an action packed week in Early Years with lots of exciting learning going on!

In Reception, the children have enjoyed exploring features of our planet through the text 'Here We Are'. They compared London to other locations around the world using Google Earth, their experiences and imagery. They then focused in on our local area, Fulham. They looked at maps to discover our local landmarks and even had a go at creating their own map of Fulham! The staff loved hearing the children share their experiences of the world, describing different locations and using comparative language to discuss similarities and differences.



In Nursery, they had several very special visitors come in to talk about their job role and share what their every day work life consists of. This enabled the pupils to understand different roles in society and how they support our community. They loved using different props to support their learning of this topic; dressing up and role playing. 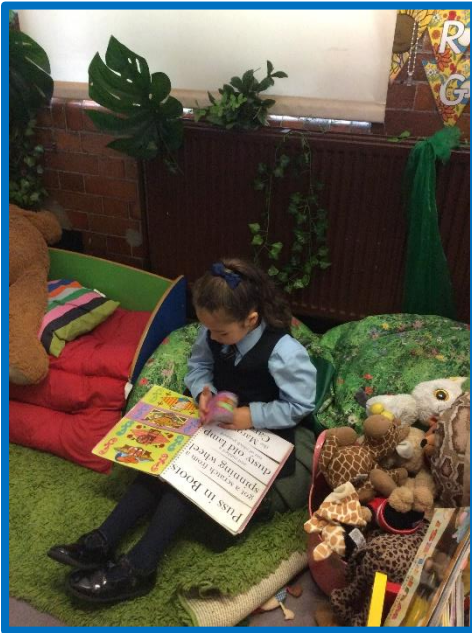

We have loved seeing our Reception pupils develop their love for stories! They have been using their phonics knowledge to read familiar words and their inference skills to retell stories to their friends.



Next Week

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be developing and using our self-confidence to perform in front of others, through drama.

Communication, Language and English

As part of National Story Telling Week we will be exploring the Traditional Tale 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We will structure the story through story maps, answer comprehension questions and discuss the emotions felt by the characters throughout. In Phonics, we will be reviewing all taught sounds and HRSWs.

Physical Development

In class, we will develop our ability to show accuracy and care when drawing.

Mathematics

We will explore addition using manipulatives, number tracks and known number facts.

Understanding the World

Through our retelling of a traditional tale, we will develop our narratives within role play. We will use costumes, puppets and pictures to be expressive.

Next Week

Communication, Language and English

We will deep dive into the story of Little Red Riding Hood as the whole school celebrates National Story Telling Week. We will read several stories about superheroes and focus on how they are helpful. In Phonics we will be developing our ability to orally blend CVC words.

We will use the books to inspire us to create obstacle courses outside.

Mathematics

We will continue to focus on 2D shapes through drawing and comparing attributes. We will also work further on patterns, extending our knowledge to ABCABC patterns.

Understanding the World

We will look at ourselves as we continue our learning of our home and world. This week we will focus on our roles in the world.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be creating our own superhero shields and masks, designed by us.
