The children in Nursery enjoyed learning that the planet they live on is found within space, along with many other planets. They learnt the names of these planets, what they look like and some of their features.

They extended their learning with a trip to the Science Museum – seeing a life size replica of a rocket, space craft and astronaut suit.

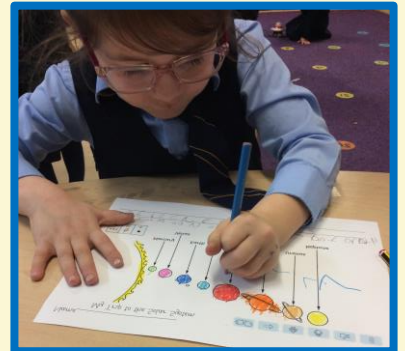

Next Week

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be talking about safe adults and who to go to for help if our safe adult isn't around.

Communication, Language and English

We will be looking at descriptive language, developing our ability to use adjectives to talk about the season of spring. We will also be exploring poetry, recognising the features of a poem and writing our own. In Phonics we will be reviewing all taught sounds and HRSW.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about the signs of the season Spring. We will explore how the weather changes; what animals do and the pollination process.

Mathematics

We will begin to learn about doubling and halving numbers to 10.

Religious Education

We will be extending our learning of why Christians celebrate Easter.

Mathematics

We will be focusing on using a ten frame to compare representations of numbers.

Our focus will be on the different materials round us that we can see, feel and hear. We will focus on using full sentences to describe the materials we find.
