If your child attends club after school and would like a snack, please ensure these go in their bags before the school day. The office are extremely busy and may not be able to pass these on to specific children.

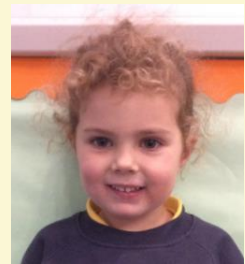
### Early Years Project – Upcycle Day

## This week

This week, Reception have enjoyed exploring non – fiction texts and sharing their own facts about dinosaurs!



## Next Week

### Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be talking about what it's like to feel lonely, sharing and listening to our experiences, and thinking about how we can help ourselves and others to feel better.

### Communication, Language and English

We will continue to use a range of vocabulary to talk about dinosaurs, and develop our ability to ask and answer questions with question words. We will be writing dinosaur facts using full sentences. In Phonics we will be practising to read CCCVC words, such as 'strong', 'splash' and 'scrub'.

### Understanding the World

We will extend our learning of dinosaurs, looking at discoveries Palaeontologists' have made. We will explore fossils with hands on and visual experiments. We will have the opportunity to ask some big questions and further our understanding through our 'Baby Dinosaurs – Life Long Ago' workshop provided by the Education Group.

### Mathematics

We will be exploring subtraction sums using known facts such as number bonds.

### Religious Education

We are going to be talking about how to care for the animals found on Planet Earth.
