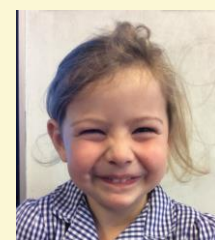

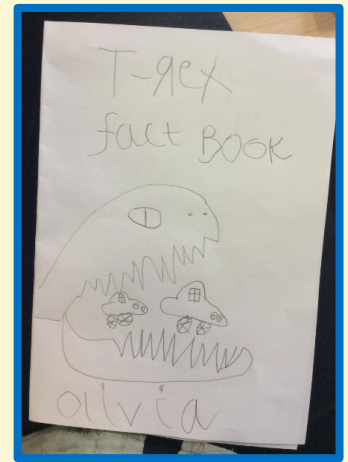

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be exploring falling out as friends and arguments, understanding the impact our words can have and why we should treat people kindly.

Communication, Language and English

We will be learning new vocabulary and phrases related to our topic of Animals Around the World. We will be engaging in a range of art and drama activities to promote the use of this language.

In Phonics we will be reviewing all learnt sounds and suffixes, as well as completing our phonics challenge throughout the week.

Physical Education

Understanding the World

We will be exploring animals around the world; recognising why they live in certain countries, looking at their habitats, and explore what the word 'endangered' means.

Physical Development

Children will focus on different ways to use their hands to move balls, including rolling, pushing and bouncing.

Mathematics

We will be creating numbers using pictorial representations up to 10.

Understanding the World

We will be looking at the different habitats of animals and the reasons that they are suited to those locations.

Expressive Art and Design

We will draw and colour different animals and create a class number line with pictures of ourselves.
