We've been learning lots more about dinosaurs in Reception this week and we've had lots of fun trying to free some dinosaurs from ice, carry out a dinosaur dig and using an iPad and then paper to make a pop up dinosaur image. In Nursery, our interest in dinosaurs led us on to some discoveries about eggs! We compared raw and cooked eggs and described their textures. We learnt how to make marbled eggs, which we peeled and tasted. Delicious! The children were very excited to watch some videos of different animals hatching, so we learnt about the different ways that animals grow, and had a go at classifying animals.
