This week Nursery have been exploring different textures, including cornflour mixed with water, bubble wrap and paint. These learning opportunities have been inside and out so that all of the children can explore in the area which they choose.



New texts have been introduced in both Reception and Nursery. Reception are studying 'On Sudden Hill', and have been busy learning how to freeze frame sections of the book. They have used large boxes to recreate scenes from the story and pretend that they are on 'Sudden Hill!'

They have been exploring colour – using watercolour paint to create rainy day pictures, whilst listening to stormy music.

Nursery have listened to 'Stickman', trying to identify the wintry parts of the story. On Wednesday they made their own Stickmen.
