This week in Reception we have been looking at the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We have engaged in lots of fun activities such as making our own Jack and the Beanstalk books and writing about the story. We have planted our own beans in the hope that a real beanstalk will grow in our classroom! In maths, we have been introduced to bead strings and thinking of our own maths stories.

This week in Nursery we have been learning about a new season – spring. We went on an environmental sound walk and we have been listening and looking for signs of spring.
