This week



Nursery children enjoying constructing and playing outdoor.

This week in nursery we have been reading "The Jolly Postman" and finding out about his adventures. Following the topic we have two new role play areas: Jolly Post Office and Healthy Eating Café. All children have been exploring and learning how to use both of the areas. We made a post box to send letters and postcards we have been designing. All children enjoyed taking roles of the postman and customers.

We have been learning about 2 D shapes in our environment and practising name-writing every day using pens and white boards.
