The children were excited to use a new tool – a pestle and mortar - to help develop those crucial gross motor skills! Many thanks to the parents who kindly lent us the equipment. We also began exploring the concept of "half". We explored halving shapes, and are beginning to have a go at halving numbers. Please practise these skills at home if you can.

This week, Nursery have been reading and finding out more about traditional tales including Little Red Riding Hood, Three Little Pigs and Cinderella. We have been exploring different materials to build the houses for three pigs. We have also been designing a dress for Cinderella using different textures and technics.

Nursery children have been practising counting to 10, ordering the numbers and number formation.

All children have been enjoying the sun this week in our EYFS playground. They have been experimenting with water and different ways of moving, making sandcastles and playing circle games together.
