Another fun and busy week here in Early Years! We've had few coughs and runny noses around – please ensure your child knows how to blow their own nose! We recommend that children look in the mirror when they clean their noses, as it helps them to ensure they 'get' everything!

In Nursery, we have been really encouraging independence in doing up our own zips, or at least having a go. We've had some very special, 'I did it!' moments! Please encourage this skill at home by allowing your child to have a go first before offering to do their zips for them.



In Reception, we have been learning about features of a sentence, and learning how to name and recognise capital letters, finger spaces, and full stops. We were introduced to adding and subtracting using the whole-part model as a visual support. We found adding easier than subtracting! Please continue to consolidate these skills at home through real-life contexts, e.g. *There were five people at the dinner table but two have left. How many children are left?*
