

(The code fostjohnswg is the code that identifies St John's Primary). Alternatively you can download the easy donation reminder which provides a little reminder every time you shop online.



Make a Purchase: Buy from John Lewis as normal. The price is exactly the same but the retailer will know you have come via our link on easyfundraising.



Get a donation: After you make your purchase, John Lewis will donate a percentage of the total spend as a donation to the school with **no extra cost to you.**
