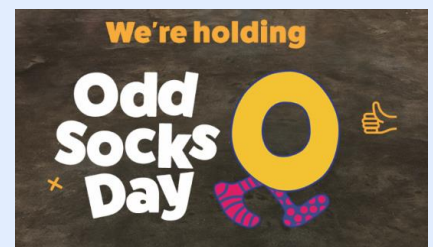
Parking on Munster Road
