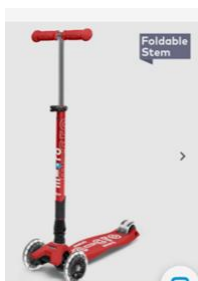


MESSAGES FROM THE HEAD TEACHER

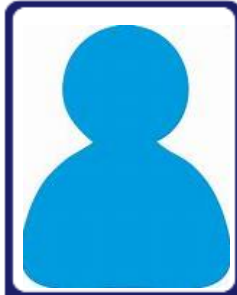
